Adverbs of frequency

THAT'S A LIE

Each student writes three sentences about things they do e.g.

- 1- I do judo three times a week.
- 2- I often go to football matches.
- 3- I never do my homework.

Students decide which statement is a lie and score points accordingly.

Irregular Verbs

BINGO

- 1- Students prepare a 3 X 3 grid and fill it with irregular pasts. Make sure students use a pen and not a pencil.
- 2- Teacher shouts out irregular pasts.
- 3- First prize goes for a line and the second prize for crossing out all the irregular pasts.

LEXIS

Teacher or studes prepare eight numbered irregular pasts in secret and write 1 to 8 on board. In turns studes choose number and get a new letter for the number. They then try to guess the irregular past. They have to pronounce it perfectly. The student carries on choosing numbers until they guess wrong.
