

Getting to Know Each Other

- ① Invite students to ask you questions about you, the teacher.

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 - i) Ask students to write down an unusual fact about themselves on a piece of paper, without writing their names on it.
 - ii) Teacher collects up the pieces of paper.

- ③
 - i) Ask students to stand up, go and sit next to someone they don't know and to interview them, taking notes.
 - ii) Each student then tells the class about the person they interviewed. Teacher takes some notes about the students in order to get to know them a bit better.
 - iii) Teacher quizzes the class e.g. "Who has a pet dog?"

- ④ Toward the end of the class or in the next class, use the unusual facts to quiz the class some more e.g. "Who has a twin sister?" etc.
