PROPS

A giant turnip, a watering can, a cooking pot, a table and 5 chairs

THE SCRIPT

Music: In the hall of the mountain king by Edvard Grieg

(When the actors are ready, music off and stage lights on)

SCENE I: A BARE VEGETABLE PATCH BACKDROP: A dug-up vegetable patch with no plants.

> NARRATOR This is a story from Russia.

(First the old man casts the seeds on the ground. Then he waters the seeds)

Exit old man.

SCENE II: A VEGETABLE PATCH FULL OF PLANTS BACKDROP: A vegetable patch full of plants.

Enter old man.

OLD MAN Oh! This turnip is enormous! I want to eat it for my tea.

(The old man tries to pull up the turnip)

OLD MAN One and two and three and pull! I can't! Old woman! Can you help me, please?

> OLD WOMAN Yes, I can

OLD MAN Are you ready?

> OLD WOMAN Yes, I am.

OLD MAN AND OLD WOMAN TOGETHER One and two and three and pull! We can't!

OLD WOMAN Boy! Can you help us, please?

> BOY Yes, I can.

OLD WOMAN Are you ready, boy?

> BOY Yes, I am.

OLD MAN, OLD WOMAN AND BOY One and two and three and pull! We can't!

BOY Girl! Can you help us, please.

> GIRL Yes, I can.

BOY Are you ready,girl?

> GIRL Yes, I am.

OLD MAN, OLD WOMAN, BOY AND GIRL One and two and three and pull! We can't!

GIRL Doggy! Can you help us, please?

> DOG Woof! Woof! Yes, I can!

GIRL Are you ready,doggy?

DOG

Woof!

OLD MAN, OLD WOMAN, BOY, GIRL AND DOG One and two and three and pull!

(The turnip comes out!)

OLD MAN

Come to my house. I will make you rice and turnip stew for your tea.

SCENE III: THE OLD MAN'S HOUSE BACKDROP: The old man's kitchen

(The old man takes the pot and serves everybody sitting at table)

EVERYBODY Yummy, yummy in my tummy!

NARRATOR And they all lived happily ever after.

Stage lights off

THE END
